



Order pursuant to section 26 of *Inquiries Act 2014*

Commissioner: The Honourable Margaret McMurdo AC

Date of order: 1 April 2019

How made: On written application by the witness identified in the confidential submission dated 29 March 2019.

THE COMMISSIONER ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to s 26 of the Inquiries Act 2014 (Vic):
 - (a) the public streaming of the evidence of the former police member who has sought this order not include his real name, address, his current place of employment, the location at which he was last stationed or his image, and, after being sworn in, he be referred to during his evidence by the pseudonym Kruger;
 - (b) publication is prohibited of any material that would identify the former police member as being a witness in the proceedings of the Royal Commission or any information that would enable his identity as a witness to be ascertained.
2. The written submission provided to the Royal Commission in seeking these orders be placed in a sealed envelope marked confidential and not be opened by anyone other than Commission staff without an order of the Commission.
3. The name of the former police officer can be accessed on request by accredited media from the solicitors assisting the Royal Commission and otherwise on application to the Commission.
4. A copy of this order is to be posted on the door of the hearing room and the rooms into which the hearing is being transmitted.
