



ARTICLES OF CLERKSHIP made 26 February 1996**BETWEEN:**

GEORGE IAN STOGDALE of Molomby & Molomby, Barrister and Solicitor
of the Supreme Court of Victoria ("Principal")
of the first part

AND

NICOLA MAREE GOBBO of 5 Fenton Avenue, Kew 3101
("Clerk")
of the other part

WITNESSETH as follows:

1. The Principal covenants to take the Clerk as his Articled Clerk for the period of one year from the date hereof and for any further period which she may be required to serve under the Rules of the Council of Legal Education for the purpose of completing the period of service required by the said Rules.
2. The Clerk binds herself Clerk to and covenants with the Principal for the said period faithfully and diligently to serve the Principal as his Clerk in his profession of a Barrister and Solicitor which he practises in the City of Melbourne at all times during the said term as a faithful Clerk ought to do.
3. The Principal covenants with the Clerk that:
 - (a) he will take the Clerk as his Articled Clerk during the said period and will to the utmost of his skill and knowledge instruct the Clerk or cause her to be instructed in the practice and profession of a Barrister and Solicitor of the said Supreme Court and will afford the Clerk all practicable opportunities of gaining experience in all classes of business transacted in his office and in particular by giving the Clerk access to papers and by enabling her so far as her ability extends to take part in the preparation of advice to clients, in drawing documents and in the actual conduct of

litigation and save in special circumstances he will allow the Clerk to attend lectures and courses of instruction held during office hours on any subjects in which she is required to qualify before being admitted to practise as a Barrister and Solicitor.

- (b) he will at the expiration of the period of service required by the Rules of the Council of Legal Education use his best endeavours to procure the Clerk to be admitted to practise as a Barrister and Solicitor of the said Supreme Court provided the Clerk will have faithfully served during the period required by the Council of Legal Education and shall have qualified herself to be admitted to practise as aforesaid.

4. The Principal and the Clerk further agree:

- (i) that they will not enter into any employment contract which purports to have effect during the period of these Articles if such contract is inconsistent with these Articles;
- (ii) to the extent that any terms of any such employment contract are inconsistent with these Articles then those terms shall be void and of no effect.
