5.3 Interstate practitioner

A registered interstate practitioner or an interstate practitioner otherwise required by the *Legal Practice Act* to make a contribution (not including a body corporate) who received, or was a partner or employee of a firm, or a director or employee of an incorporated practitioner that received trust money in Victoria, exceeding \$500,000 in total during the year ending 31 March 1997 \$200

5.4 Employee practising certificate and not authorised to receive trust money
