

MS GOBBO: No, [REDACTED]. I've never spoken to [REDACTED]. I'm sure there are cameras being installed [REDACTED], just not the ones he thinks are being installed.

Peter Smith-O

O.K.

MS GOBBO: Hopefully.

Sandy White-O

: Has he had problems with the cameras at home?

MS GOBBO: He said he had a problem with one.

Sandy White-O

: At home.

MS GOBBO: Yeah. I never really pursued finding out and hurrying the camera thing along because - - -

Peter Smith-O

No.

MS GOBBO: - - - I thought - - -

Peter Smith-O

: No.

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O

..... he's putting cameras at home
all right. Do you want to talk about - - -

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O

: - - - down the track if - if the operations come to

a conclusion, what happens after that.

Sandy White-O : No, we might see first.

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO: No, go on.

Peter Smith-O : No.

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O : There's too much. This is stuff that can wait I think.

Sandy White-O : That can wait.

MS GOBBO: No, that's one of my questions.

Peter Smith-O : Go for it.

Sandy White-O : What's - what's the question?

MS GOBBO: What happens at the end?

Sandy White-O : For you?

MS GOBBO: Of [REDACTED].

Sandy White-O : For [REDACTED]?

MS GOBBO: Of [REDACTED]

Sandy White-O : What, when he gets arrested?

Peter Smith-O : In what sense

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Peter Smith-O : Good question. Talk about it. How do you see it?

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O : Let's forget about the timing. Let's just say when it happens.

MS GOBBO: No, no, you can't forget about the timing because my credibility as far as he's concerned will be non-existent if he's arrested before the [REDACTED].

Sandy White-O : [REDACTED] - but [REDACTED] like [REDACTED] and like a lot of people that are committing crime, he could get arrested at any tick of the clock beyond anybody's control.

MS GOBBO: Yes.

Sandy White-O : That [REDACTED] could go up in a ball of flames.

MS GOBBO: Unlikely but yes.

Sandy White-O : Well

Peter Smith-O It's [REDACTED]

Sandy White-O It has happened to him before so - - -

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O :

Sandy White-O : But, you know, the point is he could get
arrested at any tick of the clock either by design or by
accident.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Sandy White-O : And the first thing he's gunna do we would
assume is that he would ring you.

MS GOBBO: He'll ring no-one else but me.

Sandy White-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Sandy White-O And what - what would be your response?

MS GOBBO: do not say a word.

Sandy White-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO:

Sandy White-O

: Ane one of the things that's concerned us a little bit is - - -

MS GOBBO: One of the things.

Sandy White-O

: A lot of things but - - -

MS GOBBO:

Sandy White-O

: the most concerning. [REDACTED] will be afforded every opportunity to speak to a solicitor and obviously that's gunna be you and everything will just go on as it normally would.

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Sandy White-O

: He would have an expectation that you'd represent him.

MS GOBBO: Yes.

Sandy White-O

And how does that work?

MS GOBBO: I'll just send him a message, "What happened to you?" or shall I call him? I'm only joking. Go on.

Sandy White-O

How does that work?

MS GOBBO: If?

Sandy White-O

: If you represent him whilst at the same time you've been instrumental in his apprehension.

MS GOBBO: Yeah, that's - yeah, that's one of the things that keeps me up at night.

Sandy White-O

: Have you got a plan how you're gunna manage that or - - -

MS GOBBO: What's the big deal? You're not gunna tell him

Sandy White-O

: No, we're not but - - -

MS GOBBO: Nor am I. I don't really feel like being dead this month. I'm not saying

Sandy White-O

: Yeah, see, I'm not - I'm not thinking that you're gunna be compromised. I'm just wondering - - -

MS GOBBO: How I'm gunna deal with it myself.

Sandy White-O

Ethically - - -

Green-O

Or practically.

Sandy White-O

: It's the same - it's the same issue because he's not gunna find out I suppose but - - -

MS GOBBO: Morally what you're asking.

Sandy White-O

: Yeah, and it's a problem more for you than us
but - - -

MS GOBBO: You don't care.

Sandy White-O

: Well - - -

MS GOBBO: Like, you care about what I'm thinking but you don't
care about from his point of view. True?

Sandy White-O

: Well, we care about the position that we are
putting you in. Granted you're the - you're the master
of your own destiny

MS GOBBO: I told you - remember talking about this
right at the beginning that this would end up being a
real problem and I knew it would be. What can I do? I
mean - - -

Green-O

How would it run practically on the night? Say you
get the phone call, "Look, I've just been arrested."

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Green-O

: "Say nothing. I'll be there in 10 minutes."

MS GOBBO: yeah.

Green-O

|: And you don't have to answer these questions if
it's breaching - - -

MS GOBBO: No, no, no.

Green-O

I'm just trying to work it through in my head. You'd have the initial he'd be put on tape, obviously afforded ring the solicitor, blah blah blah blah. Interview suspended. You go in and say, "Look, [REDACTED] say no comment" - - -

MS GOBBO: No, I'm not gunna say that.

Green-O

: and then an interview - a brief interview would take place 'cause he's gunna say no comment and then - - -

MS GOBBO: Not necessarily.

Green-O

- - - then a deal might be - - -

MS GOBBO: No, he may - - -

Green-O

No.

MS GOBBO: He may talk to them in there.

Green-O

: O.K. Good point.

MS GOBBO: In the normal course of events with anyone else, it would depend upon what I was told by - by the police.

Peter Smith-O

Yeah, you would talk about probably - as you got there what have you got on him sort of thing.

MS GOBBO: Yeah, and if it's - you know, it depends if I get a
..... ha, ha, ha, you've got a conflict, we know
what's been going on sexual fantasies on
listening device. Get fucked, we're not even gonna tell
you what drug we're talking about. Well, they'll get no
comment out of every single accused - - -

Green-O : Oh, yeah.

MS GOBBO: - - - in every single room which is what happened
last time, but if they get a - lots of other times if
they get a this is what we've got and lay it on the line
..... and that's for example, spoke to
[REDACTED] when he's been picked up from wherever he's been
picked up and driven back to wherever.

Green-O : Would that be the best time to talk? Would it be
better to talk to him that - - -

MS GOBBO: Yeah, absolutely.

Green-O - - - time or after an initial - - -

MS GOBBO: No, beforehand.

Green-O : - - - one minute get the record of - some record of
interview done and then sit down and talk business?

MS GOBBO: No.

Green-O

What - what would be the best practical way?

MS GOBBO: He needs to have it in his mind before he gets back to the police station, back to St Kilda Road.

Peter Smith-O

Do you reckon?

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Sandy White-O

: What, that he can save himself?

MS GOBBO: That he's fucked.

Sandy White-O

: But does he need to know that he can

MS GOBBO: Oh, no, not that he can save himself, no.

Sandy White-O

: No.

MS GOBBO: No, not I'm just saying from the time I get there - - -

Peter Smith-O

Oh, yeah.

MS GOBBO: - - - he should be well and truly - - -

Sandy White-O

: Yeah.

Peter Smith-O

: He's - he's fucked again.

MS GOBBO: But he should know he's totally completely fucked.

Peter Smith-O : With evidence at this stage.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Green-O : Like, if he's knee-deep in - - -

Peter Smith-O : For this particular matter.

MS GOBBO: Huh?

Green-O : So if he was knee-deep [REDACTED] and the same bloke that [REDACTED] ago was standing right next to him again in exactly the same position he was [REDACTED] - what was it - [REDACTED] ago now.

MS GOBBO: Not [REDACTED], that won't do much good.

Peter Smith-O : No.

Green-O : No, no like, he would then realise, "Gee - - -"

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

Green-O : "- - - I am fucked, aren't I?"

MS GOBBO: That is not enough.

Peter Smith-O : No, no, no. No, we're not saying that. We're not saying that.

Green-O

: That initial - that initial thought, "Gee, I am fucked"

MS GOBBO: fucked.

Peter Smith-O

: Yeah, that's right.

Green-O

So that initial come back to the station feeling of, "Gee, I'm not in a good position," and then later on it's laid - like, perhaps an hour later it's laid out to him, well, not only is he in a bad position to be standing in the middle of the fuckin' [REDACTED] but he's also got these other headaches.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Green-O

: Financial and then [REDACTED] or

MS GOBBO: but then - but then also, like, I mean I would be able to tell you that my ideal world, you know how I live in a fantasy world, [REDACTED] has been arrested, [REDACTED] has been arrested, [REDACTED] would be in custody, the whole shebang, so he knows - - -

Peter Smith-O

Sorry, who's [REDACTED]?

MS GOBBO: [REDACTED].

Green-O

The [REDACTED].

MS GOBBO: The [REDACTED], yeah.

Peter Smith-O : O.K.

MS GOBBO: That everyone's fucked.

Green-O : Yeah, so everyone in that - - -

MS GOBBO: In his world.

Green-O : - - - immediate world. What about the larger world?

MS GOBBO: Oh, yeah, it would be good if they're all

Green-O : It would be good.

MS GOBBO:

Green-O : No. It would be good but would it be good - - -

MS GOBBO: We'll think about conflict in a minute.

Green-O : But would it be good for - obviously the immediate world would it be good

(INDISTINCT CONVERSATION)

Sandy White-O : At the conclusion of the interview process he then

MS GOBBO: Bundled off to the custody centre.

Sandy White-O : No, no, no, he would

MS GOBBO:

Sandy White-O it would all be laid out to him then
.....

MS GOBBO:

Sandy White-O :

MS GOBBO: He won't speak to anyone else.

Sandy White-O : I'm just wondering whether he'd make the
decision on his own or he'd say, "Is Nicola still here or
can I get her back?"

MS GOBBO: No, I'm not gunna

Sandy White-O

Peter Smith-O : He'll expect you to hang around regardless.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Peter Smith-O :

MS GOBBO: Plus he'll be seeing all the other people in the
other rooms

Green-O : So you'll be around for a while so if a - - -

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Green-O : - - - an imprompt - not imprompt - a 10-minute, these are the facts type interview was done after the initial advice was given and then - then he was sat down and it was all made - the full story was made crystal clear to him - - -

Peter Smith-O In a calm and measured and - - -

Green-O : - - - and - and then - - -

MS GOBBO: So what - when you say the full story, you mean the full - - -

Green-O : Like the financial side and - - -

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Peter Smith-O | These are your other problems, [REDACTED], it's not just the one.

Green-O | : And then - and then perhaps there's areas he might be able to help the police if he was to - I don't know. This is why we touched on this before. Would he go and deliver or the other side? I don't know.

MS GOBBO: I don't know that he would and I think that's

fraught with massive problems because you're not gonna be able to - how are you gonna arrest him and keep - - -

Sandy White-O

Keep it quiet.

MS GOBBO: - - - secure and quiet.

Peter Smith-O

Yeah.

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O

You can easily not charge him and keep him under wraps but keeping it quiet is gonna be pretty fuckin' hard.

MS GOBBO: Yeah

Green-O

: Perhaps we - perhaps we can't test [REDACTED]

Sandy White-O

:

Green-O

: We'll get

Peter Smith-O

{ We'll get - we'll get uniform to do [REDACTED]
over - - -

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O

: - - - get them - get them to knock on the door.

MS GOBBO: They can use your favourite line. This is a normal

thing I get hit with. I call people spastics. I'm waiting for that.

Green-O : I'll be kind.

MS GOBBO: Huh?

Green-O : I'll be kind

Peter Smith-O : Do you see - O.K. No-one can predict what [REDACTED] will do and then ultimately he may not feel enough pressure on him but there's gunna be a fair bit.

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Peter Smith-O : O.K. So ultimately he's got to jump over the line and do what he wants to do. Do you see anything wrong with that general scenario - - -

MS GOBBO: No.

Peter Smith-O : - - - otherwise? Would you - - -

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O : Would you do it - would you do it differently for him?

MS GOBBO: No.

Peter Smith-O : And when it comes to that no comment or

whatever he says, it doesn't really matter

MS GOBBO: You won't get anywhere - you won't get anywhere with him unless you allow him to [REDACTED] 'cause by then he'll be [REDACTED].

Peter Smith-O : O.K. Anyway, post formal interview - - -

MS GOBBO: Not that police ever care about that.

Sandy White-O : What does he [REDACTED]?

MS GOBBO: Anything - - -

Green-O : [REDACTED].

MS GOBBO: - - - he gets his hands on.

Sandy White-O :

MS GOBBO: No, I have them so don't worry but he always [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

Peter Smith-O : What's that?

MS GOBBO: Anything.

Green-O : At the end of the day, like - - -

Peter Smith-O : [REDACTED].

MS GOBBO: No [REDACTED].

Green-O

- - - just a simple tactic would be he's not allowed to [REDACTED] till after the interview and then when he - when the initial preliminary interview is done then he can just [REDACTED] and not let him stop for two hours while he's contemplating the future of his - - -

MS GOBBO: Not let him stop is right. When he gets very stressed he just [REDACTED].

Peter Smith-O

: The thing is if you let him [REDACTED] he might explode, all the [REDACTED].

Sandy White-O

: Now, we appreciate that if you maintain the position whereby you act for him, you can control what information gets asked at bail hearings and what information gets asked for at committals and - - -

MS GOBBO: Mm'hm.

Sandy White-O

: - - - et cetera, et cetera, which is

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O

: What do you think of that?

MS GOBBO: what difference

Green-O

:

MS GOBBO: Is it illegal?

Green-O I wouldn't put it in that strong a term.

Peter Smith-O : It's not?

Green-O but it would create extra dramas for you or less dramas for you or is it a balancing thing where the dramas that might arise - - -

Sandy White-O : Look, purely a technical point of view, if - if you talk to [REDACTED] and give him legal advice before he's interviewed and he makes a confession - and I'm speaking theoretically here, right.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Sandy White-O : O.K. I'm not saying this is gonna happen.

MS GOBBO: Mm'hm.

Sandy White-O | : But wouldn't - wouldn't it be the case down the track that a defence barrister could argue, well, the advice that he got prior to participating in the record of interview was not impartial because it was done on behalf of the police by a person that was acting for the police.

MS GOBBO: Who in the fuck is gonna say that?

Sandy White-O | : It's a theoretical question, right. It's not -

I'm trying to

MS GOBBO: anybody say that? Why would anyone say that?

Sandy White-O : No-one's gonna say that but I'm trying to understand what - the conflict of interest area is not something that we ever deal with, all right, for you and it's - I mean, some people could put up an argument that a person who is a barrister perhaps could never help the police and still represent the person that she's helping the police with. So I'm just trying to get my head around this. Could you - maybe it's even pointless talking about it because you might actually think I'm going

MS GOBBO: Probably but what's the real point?

Sandy White-O : Forget it. I'm just - - -

MS GOBBO: No, no, no, what's the real point?

Peter Smith-O | : Just the general ethics of the whole situation.

MS GOBBO: The general ethics of all of this is fucked.

Peter Smith-O : What about the general legality of it then?

MS GOBBO: It's not illegal. What's - what's unlawful about it? Seriously, what - it's more unlawful having - - -

Peter Smith-O

: Well, we - we can rationalise - - -

MS GOBBO: - - - a conversation about drug trafficking with all these people every day.

Peter Smith-O

|: We can rationalise - - -

MS GOBBO: That is potentially more - - -

Peter Smith-O

|: Yeah.

Sandy White-O

: The general ethics of - some people would say the ethics of using anybody to provide information is - is wrong.

MS GOBBO: Yeah, but - - -

Sandy White-O

: That's a point of view, isn't it?

MS GOBBO: Yeah, but that - look, ethically - there's a difference between ethically wrong, morally wrong and you're assisting the police in whatever capacity therefore you're dead full stop because it's wrong. It's not illegal or improper and I don't think - what would be unethical if I was entrapment anyway.

Peter Smith-O

: Yeah.

MS GOBBO: Look, the reality is - I think the problem is that I have come to the conclusion that but for information from me from [REDACTED] you wouldn't get him.

Sandy White-O :

Green-O :

Sandy White-O : We wouldn't doubt that and - but morally it's an easy question. Morally everything's right. What - what you're doing and what we're trying to do

Peter Smith-O : Yeah, we can see it

Sandy White-O : Morally - - -

Peter Smith-O We can see it with an unbiased view.

Sandy White-O : Yeah, yeah, that's true but just the whole lawyers ethics is something that we're not familiar with and - - -

Green-O How it impacts

Sandy White-O generally we wouldn't have spoken about this until now because sort of, you know a much better understanding of what we all think now so we're asking these questions and won't seem to be spinning off the deep end worrying about where the fuck are they coming from, why are they asking this sort of stuff for.

MS GOBBO: I just don't think - I'm got more concerns about having drug trafficking conversations than I

do about the ethics of it. I mean, I feel extremely guilty where [REDACTED] is concerned and I did on [REDACTED] afternoon but that's partly because he was really - just laid it all on the table about how fucked everything was and how fucked his future was and I actually felt sorry for him when I walked away.

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO: Not felt sorry for him as in felt sorry like I want to sit there and go, "[REDACTED] sorry I've got to tell you, you're so off it's not funny and change your location immediately," not over-riddled with that much guilt, don't - - -

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO: - - - misinterpret me, but I mean just I suppose human.

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO: You spend enough time with these - with someone, you do feel bad.

Sandy White-O : Well, if he was an asshole you wouldn't feel bad because he's an asshole.

Peter Smith-O : And if - - -

MS GOBBO: No, he's not. He's not.

Peter Smith-O

And - - -

MS GOBBO: If it was Tony - how many times did I tell you I wanted to kill Tony on the phone. I wanted - I had homicidal thoughts every second day with him. [REDACTED] is a different - he's a different sort of person.

Peter Smith-O

| And I'll just throw that back at you in a slightly different way.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Peter Smith-O

Because that's part of the reason why we're asking you these things.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Peter Smith-O

: O.K.

MS GOBBO: What - hang on. Why?

Peter Smith-O

Because we've been dealing with you for some time and we roundtable these ethical-type questions - - -

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Peter Smith-O

| - - - and how it's gonna affect you and we just want to bring it up with you.

MS GOBBO: Yeah, look, it's hard, it is, but each of them is

different. [REDACTED] is hard.

Green-O

I suppose you balance it out with the damage that [REDACTED] is doing essentially as part of building up this criminal enterprise.

MS GOBBO: Yeah, but I can't solve - I can't solve the problems of the world and

Peter Smith-O

: No, only the bits you know about.

Green-O

That's right.

MS GOBBO: No, the problem because I was being - you know, not that I was being told all sorts of things for years and years and putting them together 'cause I spent far too much time thinking about things than anything else. The problem was being used by people to, you know, manipulate all sorts of systems - or not so much criminal justice system but really being used by people. That's what it - that's part of - that part of it was a guilty conscience I guess but it's not from - not from doing anything illegal myself but from knowing about these and not doing anything about them. With [REDACTED] it's just gone way in one direction because he's now decided that - I mean, I'm almost or probably bordering on conspiring with him where, you know, when I sit down and have these conversations with him and he's telling me about how much he's [REDACTED] and how much this and how much that. Why am I the equivalent of an aider and abetter?

Green-O

What are you doing to assist?

MS GOBBO: O.K. Forget about assisting but I'm encouraging.
I'm inciting him. I'm conspiring with him.

Sandy White-O

You're not inciting him.

MS GOBBO:

Green-O

: Yeah, you'd have to be - like, if you were a
[REDACTED] engineer and you're saying, "No, no, don't do
that, do it like this and you'll get another [REDACTED] out of
it" - - -

Peter Smith-O

: I can't see it though. If you're sitting there and
he's telling you stuff and

MS GOBBO: Yeah, but I'm not saying that I'm
inquiring about it, so how's this going, how's that
going. How else am I supposed to get things out of him?

Green-O

: So you'd be using that knowledge for potentially
other clients you have that are in a nasty situation.
Acquiring knowledge isn't - - -

Sandy White-O

: and all those other things.

MS GOBBO: I know.

Sandy White-O

But - - -

MS GOBBO: But, equally, look at it from the other - from an entirely different point of view. If any of find out about I am gone. Nothing you can do would protect me, nothing.

Green-O : Would they really?

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Green-O : O.K. Someone comes up to and says what would you say, what are you gonna say?

MS GOBBO: Get fucked.

Green-O : Pardon?

MS GOBBO: Get fucked

Green-O :

Peter Smith-O : How do you mean?

Green-O :

MS GOBBO: What do you mean

Green-O :

Sandy White-O : We pondered this question in the last couple of days and that was that same question and - - -

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Sandy White-O : - - - that's the response we predicted you would have

MS GOBBO: Get fucked.

Sandy White-O : Yeah, which is - - -

MS GOBBO: You're fucked or get fucked.

Sandy White-O : - - - entirely appropriate. It's an insult.

MS GOBBO: That's what I would be saying.

Sandy White-O : Because you talk to police, it doesn't mean you're a police informer and because you talk to criminals, it doesn't mean you're a drug dealer.

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Sandy White-O : And you're expected to talk to both.

MS GOBBO:

Peter Smith-O : But there are barristers and solicitors who wouldn't

MS GOBBO: And there are those that sell their clients out.

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

Green-O : It's good to ask you that question in the calm quiet of an evening rather than - - -

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

Green-O : - - - you be walking up Lonsdale Street and someone comes running up and saying, "Hey, you're talking to the cops."

MS GOBBO: Why would anyone say that to me?

Green-O : I don't know. Why do they say that - - -

Peter Smith-O : Why do they - - -

Green-O : is a police informer, why do they
.....

Peter Smith-O : Yeah, why do they say they know cops that can get code numbers checked, why do they know I got a bloke checked on LEAP and stuff when we believe that certainly some of those things didn't happen, you know, they're - - -

Green-O : If you - if you have it straight in your mind, not that we were in any doubt that you didn't already have it straight in your mind, but if you have it straight in your mind now and if it arrives, you know, you go, bang, straight to plan A.

MS GOBBO:

Green-O : I think that it would have been too but we want to know that you know - - -

MS GOBBO: That would be my response. The problem would be if there was some - some that supported it.

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO: Then it's not gonna matter what you do.

Peter Smith-O : Yeah.

MS GOBBO: And I mean it really.

Sandy White-O : It wouldn't get off first base unless somebody was standing there with cold hard evidence, "We know that you told the police this because have a look at these notes - - -"

MS GOBBO: That's right.

Sandy White-O : "- - - from this committal or this" - I can tell you it won't be on an information report but - and that's not gonna happen.

MS GOBBO: Or some copper with a big mouth.

Sandy White-O : But see, a copper with a big mouth, there's quite a lot of them. Now, and this is what I can say, if

some person goes around saying Nicola Gobbo talks to the police, well, a lot of people would say that anyway and a lot of people would say Nicola Gobbo is Tony Mokbel's right-hand man. I mean, this is all just idle gossip that floats around our circles which you would have your favourite response for.

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Sandy White-O

: So the only reason this - this is - - -

MS GOBBO: Hang on, hang on, hang on how many people in relation to - for example, when I'm confronted with [REDACTED] arrest that night or the day, whenever it's gonna be, how many people there are gonna know?

Sandy White-O

: The difficulty we've had from day one because of how you actually came to us is that there were people that had known that you were considering taking a course of action before we got involved and could drag you away from anyone else.

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Sandy White-O

Now, what we did immediately after that was say to people that - those people that had already known that you'd made an approach to Wayne Cheeseman and Mansell - - -

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Sandy White-O

- - - we told people we've spoken to Nicola Gobbo and our view is that she's on a fishing expedition - - -

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Sandy White-O
