: Yeah but this is an opportunity for Nicola to become a witness

MS GOBBO: I don't know - I don't know why Purana haven't I mean, I witnessed Renate Mokbel's affidavit.

Anderson-DS
: Yeah, you mentioned that, yeah.

MS GOBBO: I can't imagine why, 'cause Coghlan would have charged her, without considering someone like me really. I was there. I witnessed the whole thing.

Anderson-DS
: And I have mentioned that to Jim too, you know, about the quality of that brief and the standard of it

so - - -

MS GOBBO: To Jim Coghlan?

Anderson-DS

: No, Jim O'Brien, yeah.

MS GOBBO: They ought to be embarrassed. Fancy putting an -
fancy putting to prove that an
American Express card using - or obtained credit by

MS GOBBO: Yeah what am I doing. What am I supposed

to do? Tell evidence that Coghlan's crew needs to go and get to fix it up or do what I've done in the past, destroy the police case and she'll walk. What am I doing? Anyway, we can get to her. [REDACTED]

Anderson-DS : Probably topical at the moment. That's probably very important.

MS GOBBO: He hasn't rung me today.

Anderson-DS : Yeah.

MS GOBBO:

Sandy White-O : No.

MS GOBBO: Wasn't he gunna have a meeting?

Anderson-DS : Yeah, I don't know if he had it though. I don't know if he has had it or not.

MS GOBBO: Oh.

Anderson-DS : I only know what you were saying to me so - - -

MS GOBBO: Yeah, he said he was [REDACTED] today.

Sandy White-O : He said he was [REDACTED] today?

Sandy White-O

Yeah, that's right. I mean, that's another reason not to have anything - - -

MS GOBBO: I should've gone to Carl Williams
.....

Sandy White-O

: I know it probably makes you feel more comfortable when you know he's actually been found guilty.

MS GOBBO: I don't trust him.

Sandy White-O

: No. Well, when he's been found - maybe that's the worst situation. Anyway, that's the position you're in now. Whether you take the brief on or not is - that has to be a matter for you. It doesn't - - -

MS GOBBO: No, no.

Sandy White-O

: - - - matter to us at all.

MS GOBBO: No.

Sandy White-O

No, no, hear me out. Look, you could take it on and you can perhaps find some holes in it and - and maybe help them dramatically get away with whatever it is they want to get away with, or you could tell 'em to go elsewhere but no in between, you know, sort of taking it on and then pointing out the defects to us.

MS GOBBO: That's the point.

Sandy White-O

Mm.

MS GOBBO: So I haven't done anything.

Sandy White-O

Mm.

MS GOBBO: Just waiting to talk to you about it.

Sandy White-O

Well, if you want to take it on, do you think it gives you a bit more credibility with them? Whereas, you say, "No, I don't want to do anything about it, I can't help you," what are you - how are you going to explain that to him?

MS GOBBO: I don't have to explain it to him. It's pretty simple. He owes me three and a half grand from a few years ago.

Sandy White-O

Mm'hm.

MS GOBBO: he hasn't got the money to pay 'cause at the moment, apparently.

Sandy White-O

Mm.

MS GOBBO: But I think the bigger issue from my point of view - when I started with in relation to instructions everybody that I - I - that I can tell you anything about.

Sandy White-O

Mm.

MS GOBBO: The other thing is that now, why - I'm in possession of - of her brief. There's a million holes in it.

Sandy White-O

: Mm.

MS GOBBO: Horty clearly needs help in working out his evidence.

Sandy White-O

: I've got a real issue with you getting involved in - in - in that type of thing. That's - that would be an example, looking at it from the outsider's point of view, where we're actually undermining somebody's defence by adding information that we wouldn't have got - - -

MS GOBBO: Mm.

Sandy White-O

- - - until that defence was run in court and we shouldn't get. That's the way the system's set up.

MS GOBBO: Yeah.

Sandy White-O

: I don't really - I don't want to go down that track with you and convince you to go down that track. At the end of it but if you work with them, you work with them full on like you normally would. That buys you some credibility and at the end of the day that's probably a good thing if it was to come out that people were starting to say you were assisting

the police. Well, there's a clear example of where you've done the exact opposite and you've fucked over the police.

MS GOBBO: Do I really want to do that?

Sandy White-O

Well, again, that's - that has to be your decision.

MS GOBBO: Huh.

Sandy White-O

: Yeah. If you don't want to deal with it, I'm not going to be able to - if you don't want to handle it, I'm not going to be unhappy.

MS GOBBO: Yeah, but I'm - - -

Sandy White-O

That takes - - -

MS GOBBO: - - - asking what you - - -

Sandy White-O

: - - - pressure off - - -

MS GOBBO: What you think I should - - -

Sandy White-O

Off - off Purana. Well, I can see advantages both ways. There's advantages if you don't handle it, someone else might handle it and not do as good a job. That's great for us. If you do handle it, you build up credibility for yourself so that you can withstand any accusations that you're helping the police down the

track.

MS GOBBO: Excuse me, hello. I'm sorry, ^{Sandy White} but I'm fucked

MS GOBBO: He's probably somewhere.

Sandy White-O

I could. Every little bit helps, all right.
 You've got to try and get all those things working in
 your favour. And I know with undercover policemen you
 get to a point where the people you're dealing with trust
 you so much, a truckload of evidence will never convince
 the people that you hang around with that you're anything
