MS GOBBO: Yeah, I'm just saying - - -

"Otherwise she'll be" - - -

That's - that's even positive sending out - - -

Green-O - - - then there's no need for you to be involved

Meeting sooner at this point in time is probably
not better than meeting later, later meaning [REDACTED]

I'm wondering - I'm wondering if the jig's up.

MS GOBBO: Why?

'Cause if the jig's up, you can fuckin' ring [REDACTED].

MS GOBBO: I think you're overreacting without checking phones.

I'm surprised at your reaction that that's a way
out for you and you're not that keen to do it.

MS GOBBO: How is it a way out?

If we make some inquiries and - - -

 A unique situation but even more unique now.

Green-O It does. I mean, in conversations with PII in
 the future, you know, going home and having a quiet
 mental breakdown after what had just transpired, worrying
 yourself fuckin' sick about what's gonna happen to PII

MS GOBBO: - - - there are things that, you know, I would want to talk to him about and he would want to talk to me about that he won't be able to through a glass wall.
