

1 Green-O : What - - -
2
3 Sandy White-O :
4
5 Green-O : What
6
7 MS GOBBO: Well, seeing as how some police officers are going
8 to be cross examined about it, I s'pose - - -
9
10 Green-O : be cross-examined about it?
11
12 MS GOBBO: Absolutely I would - I would
13 cross-examine him about it.
14
15 Green-O About how they served?
16
17 MS GOBBO: No, about how - whether anybody checked them,
18 whether any solicitor made changes to them, whether any
19 barrister made changes to them. I'd - I would ask all
20 those questions.
21
22 Green-O : Well, he doesn't know what - - -
23
24 MS GOBBO: No, but that's the point. [REDACTED] doesn't know about
25 this bit. [REDACTED] can think - I said to [REDACTED] today on
26 the phone, "I think" - 'cause he was - he - he really
27 wanted me to come to [REDACTED] this afternoon, which, as it
28 turns out, I could've gone there but - - -
29
30 Green-O : Yeah.
31

1 MS GOBBO: - - - you know, time alone with him.

2

3 Green-O Yeah.

4

5 MS GOBBO: And - so I said to him, "No, I - look, I think I
6 might be getting statements this afternoon with Dale
7 Flynn," I'm not - like I said, I'm being vague, but I'm
8 at least telling him something to shut him up.

9

10 Green-O Mm. Now, he would know outset that you
11 would have a look at the statements

12

13 MS GOBBO: It's - he won't sign them until I do.

14

15 Green-O Yeah, that's what I thought.

16

17 MS GOBBO: Yep.

18

19 Sandy White-O But whether he's told that Tony Hargreaves got
20 them and that's how I saw them - - -

21

22 MS GOBBO: Yep.

23

24 Sandy White-O - - - or - - -

25

26 MS GOBBO: That's why - - -

27

28 Sandy White-O So I guess that's the - - -

29

30 MS GOBBO: Yeah.

31

1 Sandy White-O - - - official - - -

2

3 MS GOBBO: That's right.

4

5 Sandy White-O

6

7 MS GOBBO: Yep.

8

9 Green-O And, like, as far as - Dale doesn't know what's
10 happening. He's given me a statement but - so if he can
11 tell the truth in the witness box, he - he's got his
12 supervisor to proof-read them and it was returned to him
13 and

14

15 MS GOBBO: That's right.

16

17 Green-O

18

19 MS GOBBO: And I think it's better if Dale - Dale arranges to
20 drop them off for Tony.

21

22 Sandy White-O Mm.

23

24 Green-O Mm.

25

26 MS GOBBO: What Tony then doesn't matter - - -

27

28 Sandy White-O What, with the

29

30 MS GOBBO: - - - the police don't know about it.

31

1 Sandy White-O : That's not - that's not really I
2 don't think.

3

4 MS GOBBO: They can evidence, 'cause nobody - - -

5

6 Sandy White-O Has Horthy asked you about this specifically?

7

8 MS GOBBO: Yes.

9

10 Sandy White-O Are you gunna see his statements? Has he asked
11 you [REDACTED]

12

13 MS GOBBO: No, he told me to go and see [REDACTED] again, he said,
14 "Go and see him again, find out who's on this list, find
15 out what he's saying, the detail of what he's saying." I
16 said, "What are you - - -"

17

18 Sandy White-O Does he know that - has he actually thought
19 about it and thought, "Well, one day there's gunna be
20 statements, you might get to look at them," has he
21 ever - - -

22

23 MS GOBBO: Yes, yeah.

24

25 Sandy White-O - - - thought that far ahead?

26

27 MS GOBBO: Oh, I don't think he's thought that far ahead.

28

29 Sandy White-O

30

31 MS GOBBO: I think logical people - - -

1

2 Sandy White-O Yeah, Zara would've

3

4 MS GOBBO: 'Cause Zara and Dan - Dan's - Dan's dumb in some
5 ways, but this is the way it happens for all - - -

6

7]Sandy White-O Everything?

8

9 MS GOBBO: Yeah, I mean, it's not - - -

10

11 Sandy White-O

12

13 MS GOBBO: - - - unusual to think - like, I was thinking - - -

14

15 Sandy White-O Yeah.

16

17 MS GOBBO: - - - last night when - oh, no, yesterday when ██████
18 said to me, on the phone, I think - no, ██████ said
19 apparently and he hadn't signed any statements
20 yet. I thought - I thought for a second, "Oh, gee,
21 that's a bit close to home, like, somebody's told him
22 that."

23

24 Sandy White-O Yep.

25

26 MS GOBBO: But I figure, he's - Dan's probably said to him, or
27 Zara or both - 'cause both have been the
28 normal way these things happen is police don't arrest
29 people until they have signed and/or corroborated
30 statements. So that's - - -

31

1 the statements or read them, let's forget about reading
2 them, 'cause he wouldn't necessarily imagine or
3 contemplate that I'd get to read them but not actual get
4 them, most people - - -

5

6 Sandy White-O Yeah.

7

8 MS GOBBO: - - - would think you'd get them.

9

10 Sandy White-O And have them.

11

12 MS GOBBO: To - if he contemplated that I had them and didn't
13 tell him what was in them or circulate them - - -

14

15 Sandy White-O Mm. Yeah

16

17 MS GOBBO: - - - yeah, he'd be very, very upset.

18

19 Sandy White-O : Yeah.

20

21 Green-O Is that gunna be your next sort of on
22 the horizon will be the transition period between, I
23 suppose, actually being circulated - - -

24

25 MS GOBBO: Nuh, I've already thought of that. I'm gunna say
26 Tony Hargreaves has just got 'em

27

28 Green-O Or

29

30 MS GOBBO: Or I've seen 'em - or I'll say I've seen them, I was
31 thinking about this this afternoon. Or I've seen them,

1 but I've had to give an undertaking to a court.

2

3 Green-O Oh, yeah.

4

5 MS GOBBO: I don't know, I mean, I - - -

6

7 Green-O Yeah.

8

9 MS GOBBO: I'll cross it - the bridge when I come to it.

10

11 Green-O Yeah.

12

13 MS GOBBO: Hopefully I'll be able to avoid him for the weekend.

14

15 Green-O Yeah.

16

17 MS GOBBO: Then I've only got a few - maybe a week or two left
18 till he goes.

19

20 Green-O Mm.

21

22 MS GOBBO: Maybe.

23

24 Green-O Mm.

25

26 Sandy White-O So they get to he checks 'em, they go
27 to [REDACTED] for signing - - -

28

29 MS GOBBO: I mean, honestly, Sandy White-O Tony's never read the whole

30

31

1 Sandy White-O : Mm.

2

3 MS GOBBO: Tony doesn't know where to begin, bargaining wise

4

5 Sandy White-O Mm.

6

7 MS GOBBO: I say, and I - this is what I think, part of what I

8 intend to say to Jim O'Brien, you know, who should be at

9 our meeting when we go to the DPP - - -

10

11 Sandy White-O Mm.

12

13 MS GOBBO: - - - is, "If - if you said to [REDACTED] the night he

14 was arrested, you said to him, you said, 'You're worth

15 about [REDACTED].'"

16

17 Sandy White-O Mm.

18

19 MS GOBBO: "You said you'd back him up, but that's how little

20 he could get to if he did what you asked him to do and he

21 put everyone in the world," which he's done, I

22 think, but then I - when I've read it, I'll say

23 left out.

24

25 Sandy White-O Mm.

26

27 MS GOBBO: But if you say, "[REDACTED] down to [REDACTED]"

28 then [REDACTED] should walk, because [REDACTED] involved in one -

29 partly in partnership with [REDACTED], but a little bit

30 lesser.

31

1 Sandy White-O Mm.

2

3 MS GOBBO: A lesser role than [REDACTED] Now, if three

4

5 (PHONE RINGS)

6

7 MS GOBBO:

8

9 Sandy White-O Mm.

10

11 MS GOBBO: With [REDACTED] committed whilst on bail for [REDACTED]

12 [REDACTED] - - -

13

14 Sandy White-O Mm. -

15

16 MS GOBBO: - - - then [REDACTED] should really be looking at no time,
17 or very little time.

18

19 Sandy White-O Mm.

20

21 MS GOBBO: But no-one's gunna - part of the argument's gunna be
22 as you know, so - but the argument for the discount is
23 the fact of giving the evidence, and the fact of taking
24 the risk and the fact of - - -

25

26 Sandy White-O Mm, mm.

27

28 MS GOBBO: - - - being prepared to give the evidence.

29

30 Sandy White-O Mm.

31

1 MS GOBBO: And then the second step is the value of the
2 evidence.

3

4 Sandy White-O Mm, that's right.

5

6 MS GOBBO: And probably - tragically, no-one's in a better
7 place - a better place than I am to argue about that.

8

9 Sandy White-O And understand the value of it, yeah.

10

11 MS GOBBO: Mm.

12

13 Sandy White-O So you checked the briefs - the briefs - the
14 statements tonight?

15

16 MS GOBBO: Yep.

17

18 Sandy White-O : And what then they go to - - -

19

20 MS GOBBO:

21

22 Sandy White-O - - - either back to to cover things
23 that need to be covered or

24

25 MS GOBBO: Yep.

26

27 Sandy White-O Then that goes to Tony, he takes 'em out to
28 [REDACTED] - no, sorry, he won't take them out to [REDACTED] -
29 he'll - what's he going to do?

30

31 MS GOBBO: Give them to me.

1

2 Sandy White-O : That - so that's after they're signed?

3

4 MS GOBBO: No. [REDACTED] is not signing them until he knows what
5 he's entitled to.

6

7 Sandy White-O : So where

8

9 Green-O :

10

11 Sandy White-O : after you?

12

13 MS GOBBO: After by

14

15 Sandy White-O : Yeah, so - - -

16

17 MS GOBBO: Which will be - I can tell you, as - as quick as
18 gets them to Tony on Tuesday or Monday - - -

19

20 Sandy White-O : Mm.

21

22 MS GOBBO: The Tuesday, I'll go to on Wednesday.

23

24 Sandy White-O : Yep.

25

26 MS GOBBO: I don't - like, I don't need another week to go back
27 and read what I've read, I don't - I'm ready to go.

28

29 Sandy White-O : Yep. So if they go to Tony, that's ostensibly
30 so that negotiations can be entered into with the

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
