into the Management of Police Informants

FURTHER STATEMENT OF CHRISTOPHER JOHN NOTMAN

1. My full name is Christopher John Notman. I am a Federal Agent of the Australian Federal Police, holding the rank of Sergeant.
2. I have previously made a statement to the Royal Commission dated 29 April 2019.<sup>1</sup>
3. Since providing that statement, further diaries have been located. In the time available, I have urgently reviewed these diaries.
4. I have identified relevant entries on the following dates:<sup>2</sup>
  - (a) 3 December 1998;
  - (b) 6 January 1999;
  - (c) 20 January 1999;
  - (d) 27 January 1999;
  - (e) 10 February 1999;
  - (f) 18 February 1999; and
  - (g) 19 February 1999.
5. I have no independent recollection of the events detailed in these diary entries. I make the following observations regarding the first two of these entries.
6. The entry for 3 December 1998 indicates that I met with Person 2 with their legal advisor. My diary notes then show the name 'Ms Gobbo' with a strike through. I cannot recall what occurred during that meeting, nor whether Ms Gobbo attended or why I have struck out her name.

7. The entry for 6 January 1999 refers to a meeting I and others attended, and indicates that a 'solicitor came with informer'. I cannot recall whether this solicitor was Ms Gobbo.
8. The other entries indicate contact with Ms Gobbo however I cannot recall the details of these conversations beyond what is noted in my diary.
