BATESON: "Well, you wanted to see us mate."

Mr Thomas "How can you give a bloke indemnity, when he's

alleged to be the shooter."

BATESON: "Well, you don't get to, well you can ask those

questions all you like but you don't get answers to

those questions."

Mr Thomas "I know that mate."

BATESON: "All I can say is that we had an offer on the table for

you since day dot."

Mr Thomas "He was around though"

BATESON: "However, your circumstances have changed

dramatically in the last week."

Mr Thomas "Mine?"

BATESON: "Your circumstances have changed dramatically in the

last week. We know things now that we didn't

know."

Mr Thomas "Hang on, I'll tell you something now, now let's get

something straight, you were (indecipherable) ...he worked it out right, and I said to him, I said listen right, I'll fucking know something that I've seen and

I'll tell them right."

BATESON: "You're talking in riddles to me

Mr Thomas "I saw something, right, and I said you want to

fucking allow him to make up stories about fucking, Carl or whatever, right, I said remember this, I fucking tell 'em what I saw, I said I don't know how you are going to get out of that one, that's why I wanted Dean

GRANDE"

BATESON: "Well you don't"

"Okay, you can't give me what I want. So why"

O'BRIEN: "If you're going to be upfront about it, tell us about

. Tell us about Jacques El HAUGE,

Tell us about Tony MOKBEL and your involvement

there, in 2002."

"(indecipherable)Tony MOKBEL."

O'BRIEN: "You're worried about that name?"

Mr Thomas "Tony MOKBEL?"

O'BRIEN: "Yeah."

"I'm not worried about Tony MOKBEL."

O'BRIEN: "All right, well tell us about that."

"What do you mean, Tony MOKBEL?"

O'BRIEN: "No, tell us about it. In 2002 and your involvement

with Mrcooper when you were running a lab

down at Rye, in 2002.

"(indecipherable) I supplied the oil, listen I was the go

between RADEV and Carl for the oil to give to

right."

O'BRIEN: "Yeah, and who was running the show? Who was

running the show?"

"Carl WILLIAMS(indecipherable), hang on if you

have a look, no we, right, everyone, we made quite sure that the MOKBELS' didn't know we had

working for us, that was always the deal.

I'm not covering the MOKBEL'S here. That's where I had the fallout, right, with the MOKBELS because

they found out I was using Mr Cooper and he got busted. In the brief right, I'll tell ya, okay, when he

found out, that's when I had the fallout with

MOKBEL, not Tony, with Millsy. I'll tell ya, nothing to do with Mircooper right, when Millsy found out

BATESON: "Have you discussed this with Carl?"

BATESON: "How do you know this?"

"Right. I will tell ya, what I just told you those

names, no dramas"

O'BRIEN: "Yeah."

Mr Thomas

"His co-accused, he got pinched."

O'BRIEN:

"Whose co-accused?"

Mr Thomas

"Carl and Hutchy's. Have you worked out where I'm

getting the information from."

BATESON:

"I can't get where you are getting information from."

Mr Thomas

"How do you get information like that?"

BATESON:

"I don't know. You tell us."

O'BRIEN:

"Are you telling me it's coming out of the police ranks

are you?"

Mr Thomas

"It's come from there somewhere."

O'BRIEN:

"Yeah. Who?"

Mr Thomas

"That's it. I don't know It's coming from there.

(indecipherable)"

O'BRIEN:

"Yeah, well do you know who it is?"

Mr Thomas

"No. The copper?"

O'BRIEN:

"Yeah."

Mr Thomas

"No. I do tell. I'm not going to give him up. I'll tell you why I'm not going to give him up. I'm a hundred

percent sure but I think you know."

BATESON:

"I don't know. I know him or I know?"

Mr Thomas

"You know him."

Mr Thoma

BATESON:

"Listen I'd be inclined to say where

I(indecipherable)"

Mr Thomas

"I'm fucked up(indecipherable)"

BATESON: "If you talk around in circles, unless you're prepared

to tell us"

Mr Thomas

"I've got to think of myself.do the 30, 40, 50 years, die in gaol right or look after my family or do the time and make sure my family's all right. How do I know

you can't use this against me?"

BATESON: "Talk to your lawyers about it."

O'BRIEN: "Talk to your solicitors they'll tell you."

"I'm fucked up right, I'm fucked up. Can I get my

solicitors back out here."

BATESON: "If you want to, yeah."

Mr Thomas
"Right. I get them back out here."

BATESON: "Talk to them."

O'BRIEN: "Talk to them and then make contact with us through

them, if like. See what you want to do."

BATESON: "You're fully in or, we're not interested in half way"

Mr Thomas "No, no fucken half in or half out I know what your

up to. You don't understand me ...when I give it to you but I don't want to do gaol. Can you give me some sort of, can you indicate to me(indecipherable)."

O'BRIEN: "That's up to the OPP, we can't influence that. All

that will be, your up front with us, you tell us

everything that you know, we go out and do our best to corroborate what you're saying, from we already know to be known facts, that you're not privy to and if we believe you're telling the truth we'll put the best case that we've got to the OPP and then they'll make a decision with your solicitors. At which point you'll be advised and then you make the decision whether you

want to"

Mr Thomas "(indecipherable) whether I move."

BATESON: "I can. My advice to you is that you're going to need

to be frank and full with your solicitors. Going to

have to."

Mr Thomas "Hang on, hang on. That's why I want you here, right

and that's want I want to tell him. Jim told me to be

frank. I'm going to tell Jim straight out."

BATESON: "Yeah."

Mr Thomas "Frank."

O'BRIEN: "Do you trust him?"

Mr Thomas "Hey?"

O'BRIEN: "Do you trust him?"

Mr Thomas "Yeah. Jim's alright. Jim's the one who told me to

fucken roll."

BATESON: "Well that's what we'll do. We'll get him to come

down. Might be able to come down on the weekend, I

don't know."

Mr Thomas "He won't come down on the weekend."

O'BRIEN: "All right. Well you think about it in the mean time,

what we've had to say to you and"

Mr Thomas "You can't give me any indication?"

O'BRIEN: "No. It would be wrong of us to do it."

Mr Thomas "I was just asking. Can't you see what I'm trying to

say to you. You know what I'm trying to say?"

O'BRIEN: "Yeah."

Mr Thomas "You know what I'm like. Fucking goose. Should

have just fucking rolled."

BATESON: "Well I gave you enough opportunities mate didn't I?"
