Operation PURANA


- To investigate the "gangland" killings from 2000 onwards
- Instigated by Homicide Squad Operation RIMER Murders of Dina Dibra 10/00, Paul Kallipalis 10/02 and Nirk Radev 04/03.
- Commenced 5th May 2003

Members from the PURANA Task Force conducted a 12 month major drug investigation into the activities of a number of persons of interest in Melbourne underworld killings.

When the arrest phase occurred 5 clandestine laboratories were located.

LINKAGES

- The Majority of criminal witnesses have provided evidence of organised large commercial drug trafficking over approximately 14 years.
- The majority of murders have not only clear links to AOSD production and trafficking in Victoria but on a number of occasions have been motive related.
- Evidence gained of manipulation of the court process to allow continuance of business.
- Arrests seen as occupational hazard with little or no down time in production due to succession planning.
- Massive well organised asset concealment

CIVIL FORFEITURE

- The MOKBEL crime syndicate has utilized the services of several associates to launder drug money and hide assets.
- The main targets identified to date are :
 1. **Jack SMIT** - Property Developer. Numerous assets, companies & financial transactions involving millions. Close business associate of Roula MOKBEL.
 2. [REDACTED] - Owns [REDACTED] stores in Toorak and the [REDACTED] Club. Has been nominated by [REDACTED] as a major money launderer for the MOKBELS. Trusted friend of Tony MOKBEL.
 3. **Brian WAKEM** - Director of various off/gas enterprises company in QLD. Again has been nominated as a money launderer. He has amassed a \$1.5m share portfolio for Horty MOKBEL.
 4. [REDACTED] - Buys and sells [REDACTED] for Horty, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] using [REDACTED]. Obtains [REDACTED] for their wives using [REDACTED] etc.
 5. **Steve CVETANOVSKI** - Property Developer. [REDACTED] has nominated him as a money launderer. He has actively assisted in providing finance to manufacture amphetamines. Currently has files to 7 residential properties. Both he and his wife have put through \$2m at various times.



