

Mr Cooper

States:-

1. My full name is ^{Mr Cooper} I am [REDACTED] years of age.
2. I make this statement in the belief that the information I provide to the police cannot be used against me in any future court proceedings.
3. I have made a statement to police detailing my involvement in manufacturing methylamphetamine. This includes events on, and preceding, 13 February 2002 where a fire occurred at [REDACTED] Pascoe Vale South because of my efforts to manufacture methylamphetamine.
4. In relation to this matter I can add the following information. At the time of this fire I had access to two motor vehicles. The first was an XF Ford Panel Van which I owed. Police have asked if [REDACTED] was the registration of this vehicle and although I initially could not have recalled this, I can identify that once told, this was the registration number. I sold this vehicle to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] around August, 2001. I gave it to him and he was supposed to pay me \$300.00 but he never did. I don't think [REDACTED] ever got the registration for this car out of my name until the registration was due.
5. I also had access to another vehicle, a Madza 2000E van. I cannot recall the registration of this vehicle, but I know it was registered to Tony Mokbel and had previously been owed by a flower shop. Tony Mokbel had sold me the van.
6. Tony Mokbel sold me this van in early March, 2001. We agreed I would pay \$12,000.00 for it. This money was to be dedicated from my share of the profits when I manufactured methylamphetamine for him. I never actually paid this to him because he was sent to prison.

7. I purchased the van because it was bigger than the XF panel van and I could carry more glassware and equipment in it. The van was an ex florist delivery van and when I got it, it still had the florist stickers on the van. It had also been in an accident and the passenger side indicator and headlight were broken. I left this vehicle in the back of [REDACTED] Reservoir for about two months whilst I repaired it. Once repaired, I started driving this vehicle to and from the [REDACTED] building site. I did not use this car to collect glassware from Tony Mokbel that was always done in the XF.


8. On 13 February 2002 I had this vehicle parked in the driveway of [REDACTED] Pascoe Vale when the fire occurred. This was the vehicle I used to drive away in. I drove it to Nacho's place at [REDACTED] Coburg. I rang [REDACTED] [PII] and then had a shower and changed clothing. I then drove the car to Mickleham Road, Gladstone Park. I left it in front of a block of flats and I then caught a taxi back to [REDACTED] [PII] then picked me up and we then went to Alex Llewenberg's office.

9. As stated in previous statements I had a number of meetings with Tony Mokbel when we were planning to manufacture methylamphetamine, prior to him being imprisoned in 2001. This includes about 6 meetings at a building site I was working on in [REDACTED] Reservoir. On one or two occasions [REDACTED] [PII] was present and participated in these meetings with Tony Mokbel. [REDACTED] [PII] also came with me to meet Tony in the vicinity of Beacon Cove, Port Melbourne where the three of us would work around the streets and discuss manufacturing methylamphetamine.


