

Mr Cooper

States:-

1. My full name is ^{Mr Cooper} I am [REDACTED] years of age.
2. I make this statement in the belief that the information I provide to the police cannot be used against me in any future court proceedings.
3. I have known Shane Moran since getting bail in December 2003. I would occasionally see or speak to him but I did not do any business with him until late 2005 or early 2006. I knew that the Mokbels used Shane as a source of methylamine (amine) and glassware. I knew this because I occasionally heard Milad refer to speaking to or seeing 'Shane' when discussing obtaining amine. I knew this was a reference to Shane Moran because during the Rye lab in 2003 Milad had mentioned getting the amine from Kiwi Joe. Kiwi Joe's son is Shane Moran.
4. On a day in late 2004 or early 2005 I ran into Shane at 'The Grove' coffee shop when I was looking for Milad or Horty, neither of which were present. Shane and I got talking about speed and I told him I produced amphetamines for Milad and Horty and he told me what he was to them, that being a supplier a methylamine. We initially spoke about how much he was selling the methylamine to the Mokbels for, which was half the price that the Mokbels were negotiating with me.
5. My deal with Milad is I would produce amphetamine and receive 30% of the money made from the sale of that amphetamine less expenses. Milad gets 70% because he arranges for the drugs to be distributed and obtains the precursor chemical ketone (P2P). The expenses that comes out of my profit is for the amine, the rental of the property and all the other chemicals required such as acetone, sulphuric acid, filter papers and general equipment. Milad states that the amine is \$4,000.00 a litre which we split in two, \$2,000.00 a litre each.

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6. **Shane told me on this day that he was charging Milad only \$2,000.00 a litre for supplying the amine. So Milad was lying to me and making me pay the full 100 percent of the amine.**
7. **Shane would not deal directly with me at this time as he feared that the Mokbels would turn on him and would cause problems as we should not really discuss ventures behind their backs. I never approached Milad about this. The reason for this was because I to was lying to Milad about the outcome of what 10 litres would really produce. I was manufacturing at Preston for Milad at this time. Milad was of the opinion that 10 litres of ketone would produce 10 kilograms of amphetamine. However I was able to produce 13 kilograms of amphetamine from the 10 litres. I provided Milad with 10 kilograms and retained 3 kilograms myself which Milad didn't know about. This, in my mind, would balance out the higher price for the amine, in fact I was miles in front.**
8. **Late 2005 or early 2006 I had a further discussion with Shane Moran at 'The Grove' café. I discussed with Shane how I was being used and how he was stating he was being used also. This was a result of debts not being paid to Shane and I. We came to the agreement that we both should stop our dealings with the Mokbels and maybe do something together in the near future. This eventuated in me buying amine directly from Shane and him supplying me with phenyl acetic acid and various other chemicals in the making of amphetamine. We decided we could make a deal more beneficial and cut out the Mokbels completely.**
9. **My agreement with Shane was he would not supply the Mokbels with methylamine anymore as without methylamine, Milad would never be able to go ahead and I wouldn't have to cook for the Mokbels again.**
10. **I kept this meeting I had with Shane a secret from Milad and Horthy.**

whilst he inspected the lights, power points and electricals that had just been installed. We talked for about 30 minutes as he didn't want to leave. I then told him he was holding us up and we all had to go. He then left.
