1. My full name is ^{Mr Cooper} . I am [REDACTED] years of age.
2. I make this statement in the belief that the information I provide to the police cannot be used against me in any future court proceedings.
3. Today, being the 9 November 2006 I have been shown a series of photoboard by Detective Senior Constable Hantsis in the presence of Detective Sergeant Flynn. Prior to looking at each photo board I read the front cover of each board titled 'Important Information to the Viewer'. Each of the photo boards contained photographs of twelve persons.
4. The first photo board, identified by number 290-2006-A, contained 12 photographs. I opened the photo board and immediately identified photograph 11. Photograph 11 was of a person know [REDACTED] I have previously made a statement to police detailing how when I was released on bail in December 2003 [REDACTED] introduced to a male named [REDACTED] who drove me to a property in [REDACTED] to teach [REDACTED] how to manufacture amphetamine. The person in photograph 11 is the same [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] I then signed this photo board.
5. The second photo board, identified by number 192-2006-A, contained 12 photographs. I opened the photo board and immediately identified photograph 5. Photograph 5 was of a person know [REDACTED]. I have previously made a statement to police detailing how when I was released on bail in December 2003 [REDACTED] introduced to a male named [REDACTED] who drove me to a property in [REDACTED] to teach [REDACTED] how to manufacture amphetamine. Once at [REDACTED] introduced me to [REDACTED]. Photograph 5 is of [REDACTED] a person I was informed on [REDACTED]. In addition to my previous statement I now recall that whilst I was teaching [REDACTED] how to manufacture amphetamine I recall that he was trying to [REDACTED]

7. The fourth photo board, identified by number 291-2005-A, contained 12 photographs. I opened the photo board and immediately identified photograph 6. Photograph 6 was of a person known as Danny Kettyle. I have previously made a statement to police detailing how Danny Kettyle assisted in the manufacturing of amphetamine at [REDACTED], Coburg North and [REDACTED], Preston. The person in photograph [REDACTED] is my Kettyle. I then signed this photo board.
