On 4 September 2002 Antonios Mokbel was released on bail. He had been imprisoned on unrelated matters since 1 October 2001.

14 to 16 September 2002

Using a truck hired by from Budget Rent-A-Car Australia, Preston depot, mr Cooper and Rimond Kachab move their clandestine laboratory equipment from McCrae to Rye.

September 2002 to 11 April 2003

Once Mr Cooper and moved their clandestine laboratory from McCrae to Rye they continued to manufacture methylamphetamine at this location.


Arcooper also had assistance from Rimond Kachab who would source and collect chemicals, cutting agents and glassware from different locations.
